Nominations from the floor will be in order. A Majority vote shall elect.

## TO READ: ARTICLE IV - Officers, Representatives and Elections

## Section 5.

At the Tri-Council Annual Meeting in an odd-numbered year, a slate of our (4) TriCouncil officers consisting of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be presented by the Nominating Committee and will serve on the Executive Committee. In addition a slate of three (3) consisting of one Environmental Consultant, one Gardening Consultant and one Landscape Design Consultant shall be presented by the Nominating Committee and will serve on the Executive Committee as Representatives providing liaison between their respective Consultants and the Officers. The slates shall be presented by the Nominating Committee. Nominations from the floor will be in order. A majority vote shall elect.
