Dear Consultants:

We are Environmental Consultants' Council and members of a large volunteer organization who educate and motivate others. Responding to our FFGC President's theme of "The Garden of Inspiration", we also need to *inspire* others to be concerned about the future of our beautiful state. We joined with thousands of Floridians who voted on an Amendment to renew state spending to acquire and protect sensitive Florida land. Amendment I passed! Florida's Water and Land Legacy Amendment became a reality! Sadly, subsequent to the passage of the Amendment, the legislature ignored the mandate of the people. Our decision makers are putting the economy of the state ahead of the environment.

As environmental advocates we have the opportunity to influence Florida's environmental policy. FFGC wants to make a difference and to bring about changes that will improve Florida's environment. And we speak with a strong united voice. When we are called to bombard legislators, news papers, and regulators with phone calls, emails and letters, we need to do it!

We need to:

- Continue to raise public awareness that our springs have reduced flow, and with our lakes and rivers, are polluted, over pumped and laced with nitrate rich run off from lawns, farms, and golf courses.
- Speak up when commercial interests are allowed to break promises and still be favored by regulatory agencies.
- Campaign against commercializing state parks as camp grounds or pasture land for cattle.
- Educate ourselves and others about the nightmare of Fracking; the process of drilling for natural gas by injecting water and toxic chemicals under high pressure a mile below the land surface to the shale level.

"Education is the Key" so FFGC proudly supports many conservation programs: Wekiva Youth Camp, SEEK (Saving the Earth's Environment through Knowledge), the Coral Restoration Foundation, Penny Pines, Florida Wildflower Foundation! And the list is longer than my space! Keep up the good work! I am happy to represent the Environmental Council on the Tri-Council of FFGC.

**“UNSOLICITED AWARDS”**  
**FOR PLANTINGS IN THE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTOR**

This project was planned to involve all members of the Landscape Design Consultants’ Council for the purpose of recognizing and encouraging well-designed and maintained plantings in the public sector. The awards are “unsolicited” in that they are not requested by the places nominated, Nominees are not notified.

Any garden club member, especially graduates of the NGC Landscape Design School may nominate any well-designed and maintained landscaped area in the public sector in his/her District. Nominations are to be made in writing and are sent to the District Chairman of FFGC Landscape Consultants’ Council or to the District Director if none appointed.

This District chairman will select panels of judges made up of members of the Consultants’ Council (see current Yearbook) of his/her District to evaluate the area nominated.\* Other interested GC members may participate on the teams. Judging will be done according to the NGC Standards – Evaluating Landscape Design. All nominations will require Point Scoring And are available from the President of the President of the Florida Landscape Consultants Council.

Categories eligible for nominations are:

1. Small business (such as gas stations, fast food, etc.)
2. Public Facility (such as library, park, police station, etc.)
3. Private Facility (such as church, hospital, etc.)
4. Private Resident or Merit.

*\*All Landscaping must have been completed for at least a year.*

*There can be one winner in each category in each District each year.*

*Winners’ Certificates will be presented at the Spring District Meetings of FFGC.*

*Certificates are available from the President of the Florida Landscape Consultants’ Council.*

## **CONSULTANT CLASSIFICATIONS (Applies to each Consultant Council)**

### **PROVISIONAL CONSULTANT**

A student who attends any two courses of school and takes and passes the exams is considered a Provisional Consultant and is eligible to join a Consultants Council. Provisional Consultant status is retained until the successful completion of all four courses of a school, passing the exams and becoming a Consultant. NGC allows seven (7) years to complete a school since the first course was taken and all credit lapses.

### **CONSULTANT**

A Provisional Consultant who completes all four courses of a school, passes the necessary exams, is a member of a NGC affiliated garden club, and subscribes to The National Gardener can become a Consultant. The Consultant may not refresh in the SAME year they become a consultant, but can refresh once a CALENDAR year thereafter and must refresh by the end of the fifth (5) calendar year after their last refresher or completion of the school.

### **MASTER CONSULTANT**

A consultant may be designated a "Master" Consultant after completing four (4) recorded Refreshers, is a member of a NGC affiliated garden club, and subscribes to The National Gardener. The consultant must personally request the Master status from the NGC Accrediting Chairman. To maintain the Master status, the member must refresh at currently specified periods as often as once each calendar year and by the end of the fifth calendar year after the last refresher. Master Consultants in all three schools can refresh for all three by attending any Tri-Refresher offered by any NGC garden club.

### **EMERITUS**

A Master consultant in good standing can request Emeritus status. The Master consultant must personally request this status through the State School Chairman.
